The first will be located at Todville and Meyer where we will replace an existing steel section of 12-inch water line that has been repaired multiple times due to leaks within that section of pipe. The second location will be along the south side of Red Bluff Rd. from old Hwy 146 to the southwest corner of Red Bluff and Bayview Dr. The existing water line servicing the area is a 2 inch thin wall plastic line that in some areas is located in the middle of Red Bluff Road. The new main will be upsized to an 8-inch water line with fire hydrants.
