10 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE**
11 **“SEABROOK COMPREHENSIVE MASTER PLAN 2035” PURSUANT TO TEXAS**
12 **LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE CHAPTER 213 AND SECTION 11.23 OF THE**
13 **SEABROOK CITY CHARTER AS PROVIDED HEREIN; REPEALING ALL**
14 **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT**
15 **HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.**
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17 **WHEREAS**, Chapter 213 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that
18 municipalities may adopt a comprehensive plan for long range development for the City, and
19 that such a comprehensive plan may include, but is not limited to provisions of land use,
20 transportation, public facilities, and to coordinate and guide the establishment of
21 development regulations; and
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23 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 11.23 of the Charter of the City of Seabrook, the
24 Seabrook City Council appointed a Comprehensive Master Plan Review Commission
25 (“Commission”), comprised of seven (7) citizens, for the purpose of developing such a plan
26 pursuant to Chapter 213 of the Texas Local Government Code; and
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28 **WHEREAS**, the Commission conducted an extensive review, conducted public
29 hearings, and received public and staff comments; and thereafter made its final
30 recommendations to the City Council for adoption of the “Seabrook Comprehensive Master
31 Plan 2035” (“Master Plan 2035”), attached hereto as Exhibit “A”; and
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33 **WHEREAS**, after the subject public hearings, studies, and reviews, the City Council
34 has considered and has accepted the recommended changes of the Commission incorporated
35 into the “Seabrook Comprehensive Master Plan 2035,” to be adopted in accordance with the
36 limitations, restrictions and requirements of Chapter 213 of the Texas Local Government
37 Code for use as a future planning device of an advisory nature only, with the specific intent
38 that the Master Plan 2035 is not to conflict with zoning regulations, which will prevail in
39 case of conflict; and
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41 **WHEREAS**, all public notices have been posted, published and all required hearings
42 on this matter have been held in accordance with law;
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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS OF FACT.

That the facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF COMPREHENSIVE MASTER PLAN 2035.

The “Seabrook Comprehensive Master Plan 2035” is hereby adopted pursuant to the limitations, restrictions and requirements of Section 213 of the Texas Local Government Code, as contained herein, Section 11.23 of the Charter of the City of Seabrook, and any map of the Master Plan 2035 illustrating future land use shall contain the following clearly visible statement “A comprehensive plan shall not constitute a zoning regulation or establish zoning district boundaries.”

SECTION 3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS.

All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Seabrook, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts

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SECTION 5. NOTICE

The City Secretary shall give notice of the enactment of this Ordinance by promptly publishing it or its descriptive caption after final passage in the official newspaper of the City; the Ordinance to take effect upon publication.
