ORDINANCE NO. 2017-03**

**AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2015 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2016
FOR THE SEABROOK GENERAL FUND**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE AMOUNT OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1, 2015 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2016, FOR THE CITY OF SEABROOK, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$776,000.00 TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AND FINDING AVAILABLE UNENCUMBERED FUNDS FOR THE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION AND/OR TRANSFER

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seabrook Approved Budget Ordinance 2015-19 on September 15, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has certified there are revenues and/or unencumbered fund balances available for appropriation in excess of those appropriated for specific expenditures in the budget for supplemental appropriation and/or transfer, and;

WHEREAS, Budget Supplement 2016-03 was approved on May 17, 2016, a General Fund transfer to the Public Works and Animal Control Complex Project in the amount of \$776,000; and

WHEREAS, such expenditures will occur subsequent to the adoption of the 2016/17 budget and will require formal appropriations; and


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seabrook desires to reduce the General Fund Unreserved Fund Balance by transferring \$776,000 to the Public Works Animal Control Fund, according to Budget Supplement 2016-03; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seabrook finds and determines that this budget amendment complies with all requirements under its Charter and laws;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, STATE OF TEXAS:


THAT, the 2015/16 Adopted Budget for the City of Seabrook for the period beginning on October 1, 2015 and ending on September 30, 2016 is hereby amended by reducing the General Fund Unreserved Fund Balance and allocating those funds to the Public Works Animal Control Fund, in the amount of \$776,000.

PASSED, AND APPROVED with a quorum present, by an affirmative vote of a majority of Councilmembers present, in accordance with Seabrook City Charter Section 2.10, on first and final reading this **3th day of January, 2017.**


