**SUBMISSION OF GRANT APPLICATION
FOR MARKED OPERATIONS VEHICLE WITH VIDEO EQUIPMENT**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, TEXAS, APPROVING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION FOR A GRANT TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR A MARKED OPERATIONS VEHICLE WITH VIDEO EQUIPMENT AND APPOINTING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL FOR ADMINISTRATION OF THE GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City of Seabrook finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Seabrook that a Marked Operations Vehicle, (“Edward Byrne Justice Formula Grant (JAG) Program”) be implemented in order to purchase and deploy a marked police unit equipped with a L3 video recording system in order to prevent and control crime and make improvements to the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seabrook agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City of Seabrook shall return all funds to the Criminal Justice Division in full: and

WHEREAS, the City of Seabrook designates Gayle Cook, City Manager, as the grantee’s authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Seabrook approves submission of the grant application for the Marked Operations Vehicle with Video Equipment to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, and appoints the City Manager as an authorized official to administer the subject grant.


