

ORDINANCE NO.2017-34

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TERMINATION OF CURFEW AS PROVIDED IN ORDINANCE 2017-33, WITHOUT REPEALING OR ABROGATING REMAINING PROVISIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE DETERMINING NEED FOR EXTENSION OF DISASTER DECLARATION FOR THE CITY OF SEABROOK

WHEREAS, on August 24th, 2017, the Mayor issued an Order proclamation declaring a State of Disaster for the City of Seabrook, Texas resulting from

Hurricane Harvey;

WHEREAS, conditions necessitating declaration of a local State of Disaster continued to exist and on August 28, 2017 by Emergency Ordinance 2017 – 33, the City Council of Seabrook ordained the continuation the local State of Disaster as ordered by the Mayor on August 24, 2017; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance provided for a curfew and the conditions necessitating the proclamation of a curfew in the City of Seabrook now cease to exist, but the conditions of a State of Disaster continues; and


WHEREAS, it is the intent of City Council that only the curfew provision be terminated and that the remaining provisions of Ordinance 2017-33 shall not be repealed or abrogated unless terminated by subsequent Ordinance of City Council;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEABROOK, TEXAS:

1. That the local State of Disaster proclaimed for the City of Seabrook by the Mayor on August 24, 2017, (other than the termination of curfew as provided herein), shall continue until terminated by ordinance of the City Council.
2. The provision relating only to the curfew established by Order dated August 27, 2017 and continued and extended by Ordinance 2017-33 is hereby specifically terminated, but all other determinations contained in said Ordinance are hereby affirmed and incorporated by reference. All prior actions by designated city staff and officials heretofore to terminate the curfew made the basis of Ordinance 2017-33 are hereby confirmed and ratified.
3. A public emergency exists requiring that this ordinance be passed formally on the date of its introduction for one reading; therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


PASSED AND APPROVED by a vote of 7 "ayes" in favor and 0


