LOCAL COMMITMENT OF FUNDS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LOCAL COMMITMENT OF FUNDS FOR THE CITY OF SEABROOK HURRICANE IKE DISASTER RECOVERY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM UNDER TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE CONTRACT NUMBER 12-564-000-6858

WHEREAS, the Texas Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery program requires the City to provide authorized Local Commitment of Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City was granted \$ 1,090,427.75 in federal funds for all Round Two (2) projects.

WHEREAS, the city was originally approved for \$100,166 from the total allocation for the Hester's Gully drainage project.

WHEREAS, the city bid the project and awarded the contract to GCP Contractors. The current contract amount including all change orders is \$153,894.50.

WHEREAS, the Hester's Gully project now requires city funds in the amount of \$74,250 to pay for a bridge, bridge extension, and asphalt for repair of the access road.

WHEREAS, the city has available funds in the General Fund to cover the bridge, bridge extension and asphalt for repair to the access road in the amount of \$ 74,250.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and opinions in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct.


Section 2. The City has funds available in the General Fund for the change order and shall allocate the funds for the change order.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
