RESOLUTION 2018-08**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, TEXAS, SUPPORTING A NO WAKE ZONE IN AND AROUND THE CLEAR LAKE AREA ON FRIDAY, JUNE 22 AND SUNDAY, JUNE 24, 2018 DURING THE TEXAS OUTLAW CHALLENGE WITH A NEW EVENT ADDED IN 2018, OFFSHORE PERFORMANCE BOAT RACING

WHEREAS, the Texas Outlaw Challenge event will hold their boat racing activities on Clear Lake from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day with scheduled time intervals of “lake open for recreational traffic”, and “lake closed in designated areas for scheduled racing activities”; and

WHEREAS, on Friday June 22, 2018, the initial event from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (Noon) will be the Outlaw Shootout Radar Runs within a buoyed safety course; followed by Offshore Race qualifying races from 12:00 p.m. (Noon) to 4:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, on Sunday June 24, 2018, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., the event will conduct the Offshore Race finals; and

WHEREAS, to provide for the safest and most successful community event, organizers are requesting that the communities around Clear Lake support a “no wake zone” and “restricted race course area” on Clear Lake during these events times; and

WHEREAS, as a Hotel Occupancy Tax Sponsor of the event and with the utmost concern for boating safety on Clear Lake, the City Council supports the “no wake zone” and “restricted race course area” during the duration of the two day event activity.


